10:00 am: The event begins with the SYV Redwood Railway running from Merced, Bakersfield, Fresno, Tehachapi Loop to Mojave. • This outdoor elevated O-Gauge layout with 600 feet of track winds its way through a Redwood Forest (radio controlled). New additions have been added to the collection, and is a must see event. • The Redwood Railway will be running through out the day.



11:00 am: The Great Train Room opens with five operating layouts

- Lionel Standard and O Gauge trains dating from the early 1900's to pre-World War II – running in 1920-30's settings, amid antique toys, building, and bridges from that era.
- Railroad China from the Southern Pacific and Santa Fe Railroads.
- History of the Pacific Coast Railway (the railroad that built the Valley from San Luis Obispo to Matte's Tavern in Los Olivos).
- Southern Pacific history of our area.
- Narrative tours: **11:00 am, 12:00 am, 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm**
